DISCUSSION:

On Tuesday, August 28, 2018 the Holly Hill electors approved two amendments to the City of Holly Hill Charter repealing the Civil Service Act and approving 4 year staggered terms.

The attached Ordinance repeals the Civil Service Act in its entirety and establishes the staggered four year terms.

To implement staggered terms, beginning with the election to be held in 2020, the Mayor and City Commissioner, District 1 and City Commissioner, District 3 shall be elected to a 4 year term and City Commissioner, District 2 and Commissioner, District 4 shall be elected to a 2 year term.

At the election to be held in 2022, City Commissioner, District 2 and City Commissioner, District 4 shall be elected to a 4 year term.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE HOLLY FLORIDA, CITY OF HILL, REPEALING **ORDINANCE 3010 AND ADOPTED PURSUANT TO** FLORIDA STATUTE, SECTION 166.031, INCORPORATING INTO THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL CHARTER AMENDMENTS, A REFERENDUM WAS PASSED DURING THE MUNICIPAL **GENERAL** ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 28, 2018, CIVIL REPEALING THE SERVICE ACT AND APPROVING THE 4-YEAR STAGGERED TERMS FOR THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSIONERS; REPEALING ALL **ORDINANCES** IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; **PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING** FOR AN **EFFECTIVE** DATE.

WHEREAS, due to scrivener's error, Ordinance 3010 is hereby repealed; and

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, August 28, 2018, the Holly Hill electors approved two

amendments to the City of Holly Hill Charter repealing the Civil Service Act and approving

4 year staggered terms; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Florida Statute Section 166.031, upon adoption of amendment(s) to the municipal Charter by the majority of the electors, the governing body shall

have the approved amendment(s) incorporated into the Charter and the revised Charter shall be

filed with the Department of State by the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, words which are underlined (underlined) are additions to the text

and words with strike through (strike through) characters are deletions from the text.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HOLLY HILL, FLORIDA:

	<u>SEC</u>	TION 2	The	City Comm	nission of the	City	of Holly	Hill, hereby	amends
Section	9	of	the	City	Charter	to	read	as	follows:

Sec. 9. - The City Commission - Creation; Term; Oath; Compensation.

There is created a City Commission composed of five qualified electors of the city, consisting of four Commissioners and one Mayor. Beginning with the election held in 2010, the Mayor and Commissioners shall serve two-year terms. During the General Election on Tuesday, August 28, 2018, a referendum was presented to the electors of the city and passed by the voters to approve 4 year staggered terms of office. To implement staggered terms, beginning with the election to be held in 2020, the Mayor and City Commissioner, District 1 and City Commissioner, District 3 shall be elected to a 4 year term and City Commissioner, District 2 and Commissioner, District 4 shall be elected to a 2 year term. At the election to be held in 2022, City Commissioner, District 2 and City Commissioner, District 4 shall be elected to two consecutive terms beginning with the election held in 2010. The present Mayor and City Commissioner shall hold office until their respective successors are duly elected and qualified and take office as herein provided.

All City Commissioners and officers of the city shall, before entering upon their duties, take and subscribe to an oath or affirmation, to be filed and kept in the office of the City Clerk, which oath shall be in the form prescribed for State Officers by the Constitution of Florida.

Department SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall file the revised Holly Hill Charter with the State.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, or application hereof, is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court, such portion or application shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or application hereof.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> That all ordinances made in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby

repealed.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its

adoption.
