

# Sunrise Park South

Location: 1125 Riverside Drive

Hours: Sunrise to Sunset

Admission: Free

Sunrise Park South is a 1.35 acre facility located on the Halifax River (Intracoastal Waterway). It currently supports an existing boat ramp, car and trailer parking, and picnic pavilions.



Sunrise Park South is on a piece of land that juts out into the Halifax River and was used by Bill McCoy as a landing back in his rum runner days. McCoy came to be known as “The Real McCoy.” [Visit our HISTORY section for more information on Bill.](#)
